Changes to Emergency Urine Drug Screens and Urine Drug Screen 12 Effective Wednesday, January 23, 2008

- Tricyclic Antidepressant cut-off concentration will change from 300 ng/mL to 1000 ng/mL. This should result in fewer false positives.
- Barbiturate cut-off concentration will change from 200 ng/mL to 300 ng/mL.
- Propoxyphene will no longer be available except as a send out test.

Orderable tests are now as follows:

ED Lab Emergency Drug Screen, 11
Emergency Urine Drug Screen, 11
Urine Drug Screen, 11

Only the Urine Drug Screen 11 automatically reflexes to confirmation for positives.
