



## Salem Hospital construction update

### April 23, 2008

#### ***Asphalt Pour***

- On Monday, April 28, Turner Construction will be paving the new main turnaround area between the COM building and the patient-care tower. This activity will take most of the day and will have some odor associated with it, similar to what is experienced while driving through a construction zone on the highway. There will be a paving machine and several dump trucks delivering asphalt in the turnaround zone throughout the day. They will access the area from the east on Oak Street. This will be the last of the paving to be done in and around the COM and FBC buildings.

#### ***Starting May 12 through August***

##### **Oak Street SE Changes**

- Turner Construction will complete the new turnaround and begin building the new landscape plaza at the west end of Oak Street SE.
- The new turnaround will be open to medical transport, shuttle, and delivery vehicles only. The turnaround will not be open to the public at this time.
- Patient and visitor drop-off locations will remain the same.

##### **Service Drive Changes**

- The service drive between the FBC and COM buildings will be closing to all pedestrian and vehicle traffic due to construction work for the new FBC retail dining space. A new staircase outside the building will be installed.

##### **Valet Changes**

- Valet locations will remain the same. They will use the lane behind the FBC building again while the service drive is closed.

##### **Pedestrian Path Changes**

- Pedestrians will be able to walk down Oak Street SE across the service drive and enter the COM building through the revolving door. They will not have to use the east entrance anymore.
- The pathway behind the FBC and COM buildings will be closed to pedestrians while it is used for valet service.
- An updated map will be coming soon.
