Parking access gate installation, data center work on Winter Street SE, final site work, tower security and access

Parking access gates installation in process; work in current emergency lot begins Jan. 26

- Nine parking access gates are being installed at parking locations around campus. These gates will help preserve patient, visitor, and staff parking.
- Gate arms will remain upright and the gates will be inactive until Salem Hospital's complete parking inventory is turned over to us.
- The work will continue through about March 9.
- Beginning Monday, Jan. 26, the north entrance to the current Emergency Department parking lot will have an island installed to accommodate the access gates.
- Turner will pour the island in two sections and two lanes of traffic will be open at all times. Cones will be placed to direct drivers.

Generator removal from data center on Winter Street SE begins Jan. 26

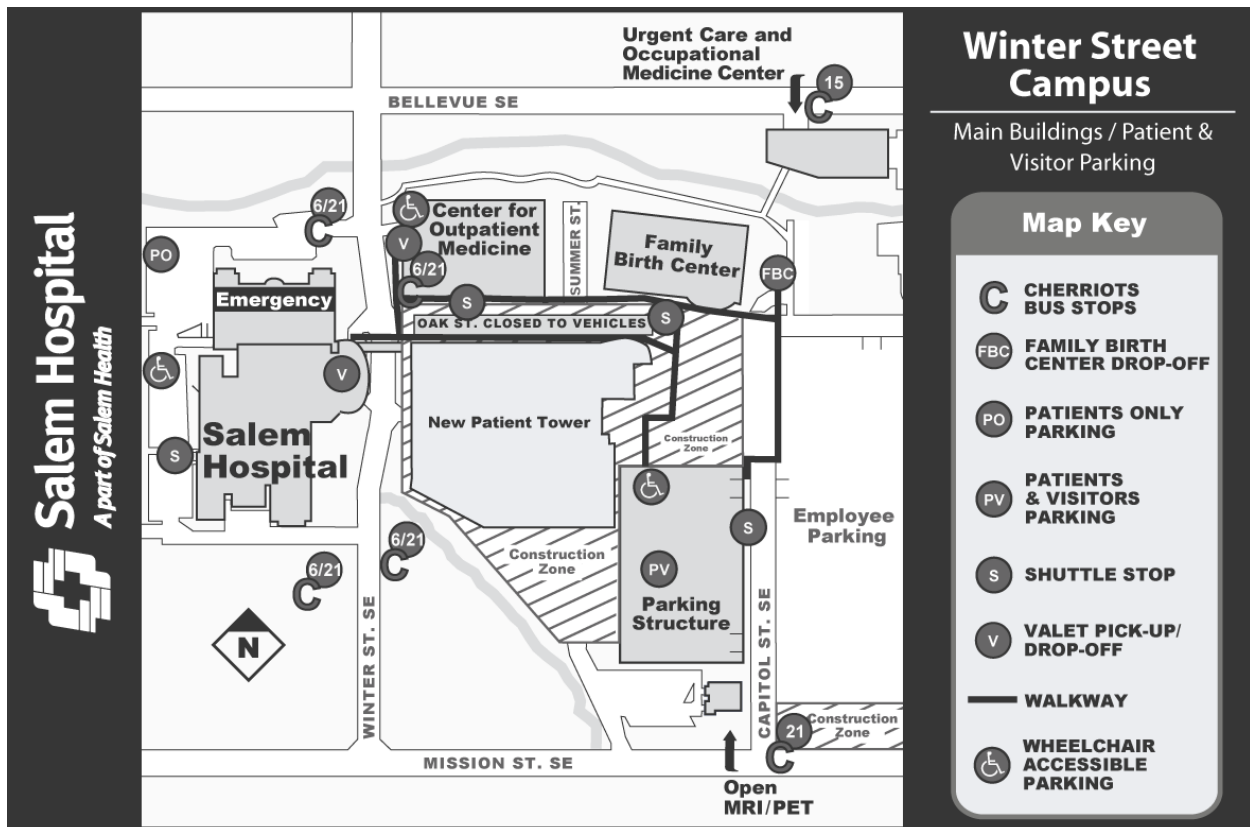
- Generators located in the data center on Winter Street SE are scheduled to be removed from the site Jan. 26 through 30.
- A crane will be placed in the northbound lane of Winter Street SE, blocking it completely for the duration of the work.
- When equipment is being transferred in the air to a waiting truck, Winter Street SE will experience short closures lasting five to ten minutes, due to the complexity of the work.
- Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic.
- Please use caution and follow all designated pathways.

Final site work continues through May

- Over the next several months Turner Construction will be finishing the site work on campus.
- This work includes installing campus signage, installing landscaping around the data center and employee surface parking lot, and some work on Winter Street SE.

Tower security and access through May

- Access to the new patient-care tower will continue to be scheduled in advance and limited to those who have a specific need to be in the building.
- Fencing will remain to protect the security of the building and its contents.
- Salem Health employees and medical staff working in the tower will tour the building and train in the tower before it opens.
- All employees, staff, volunteers, and the general public will have the opportunity to tour and celebrate the opening before the building opens in May.
