



Salem Hospital construction update February 17, 2006

Safety reminder

If you are not an employee of any of the construction companies, be sure to stay out of the fenced construction areas. Stay safe!

Capitol Street SE

- Utility work on Capitol Street will limit parking along the West side of the street. Signs will be posted during the times when parking is restricted.
- Trucks are entering and leaving the new surface parking lot between Capitol and University Streets. Flaggers will be directing traffic when a truck comes on site.
- The water-line installation for the new fire hydrant on the east side of the employee parking is in progress. Watch for flaggers here, too.
- The green space and sidewalks between the street and employee parking garage on Capitol Street will soon be fenced off, so the new shuttle shelter, walkways, and ramp can be built.

Oak Street SE

- PGE work on the North side of Oak Street will limit parking. The first phase will occur between 12th and University Streets. As the work moves westward, parking in the completed sections will be reopened.
- Sidewalks and curbs are being replaced on the South side of Oak Street from about Feb. 20 through March 10. There will be no parking on the South side of Oak Street during that time.

University Street SE

- University Street, between Leslie Street and the alley, will be closed from about Feb. 27 through April 14, so underground utilities that need to cross the street can be installed.
- The sidewalk on the West side of University will be closed for about three weeks while PGE does work between Mission and Leslie Streets. Watch for truck traffic.

Surface parking lot

- Work continues to build the surface parking lot on the site East of the employee parking structure between Oak and Mission Streets. This lot will be completed and ready for use before the demolition of the visitor structure.
- Paving will begin on the South portion of the lot, which will be used for construction trailers and subcontractor staging, so their vehicles do not park in patient parking areas.

Central Energy Plant (CEP)

- The sidewalk on the North side of Leslie will be closed until November. The South sidewalk is still open for pedestrian access.
