## Capitol Street site work begins Oct. 13

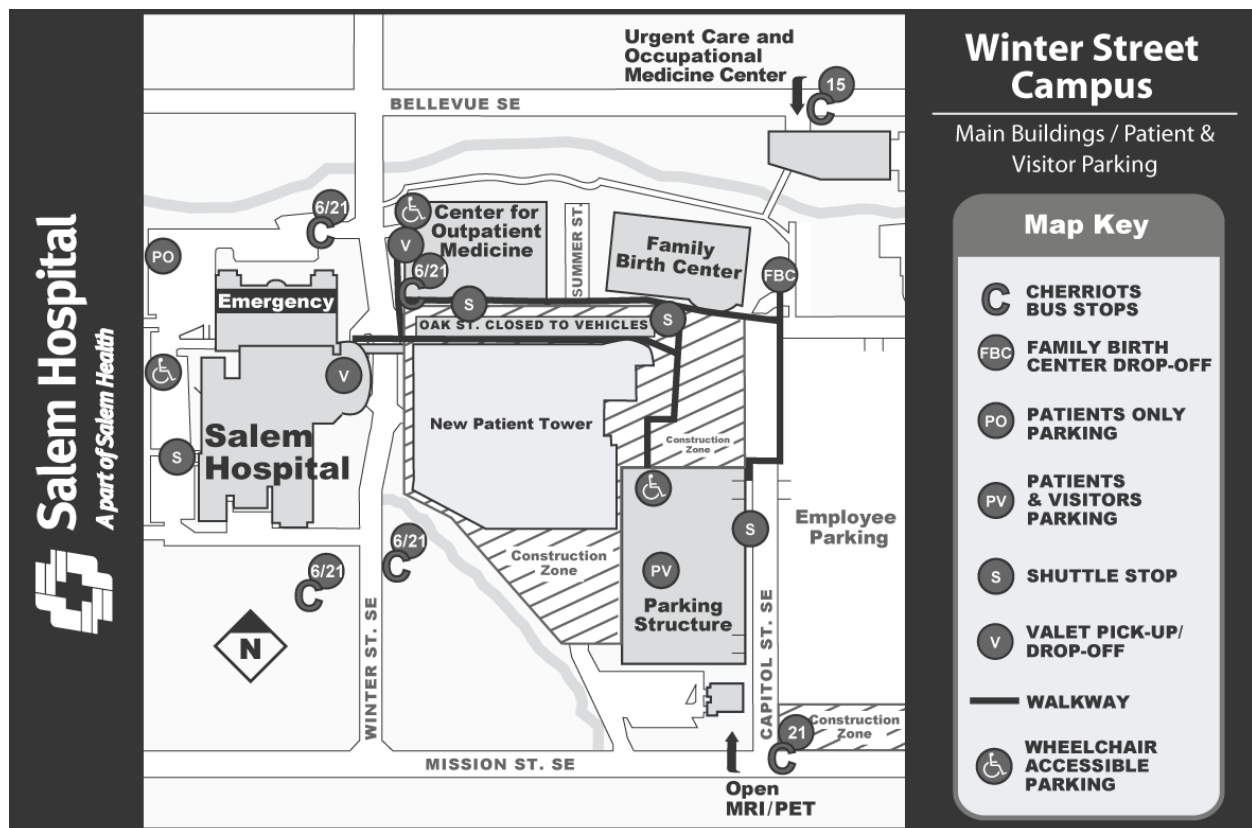
### Construction on Capitol Street SE — east sidewalk

- On Monday, Oct. 13, Turner Construction will begin work on the east sidewalk on Capitol Street SE.
  - The temporary covered walking path on the east side of Capitol Street SE is being demolished. A walkway along the north side of the parking garage has been opened. Pedestrians can walk under cover by walking on the path inside the parking garage.
- Pedestrians will cross from the surface employee parking lot to the west side of Capitol Street to access the new path north of the parking garage.
- A new sidewalk will also be poured on the east side, and the work is expected to last one week.

### Road work on Capitol Street SE and Oak Street SE

- Beginning Oct. 13, Turner Construction should start to work on Capitol Street SE, north of the parking garage entrance through the intersection of Oak Street and Capitol Street.
  - The first stage of road work will be done only at night; from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Flaggers will be available to assist traffic.
  - Beginning Oct. 15, Turner Construction should begin paving this area. One lane of traffic will remain open at all times. Flaggers will be available to direct pedestrian and vehicle traffic.
